

# TeamCity Integration for JIRA 2.2.0

## New in this release

Added a capability to remotely trigger builds on TeamCity server from JIRA.

Now you can instantly and directly run builds while viewing JIRA issues. You need to add a [custom field](#) into the related screens and set its configuration. Then you can remotely [run builds in TeamCity from JIRA](#) and [view history of builds](#) that were run from JIRA.
