
New in this release:

Added a new chart type to the Chart From Table macro - Bubble Pie chart.

The chart combines bubble and pie chart types and allows you to compare your data ranges relative to each other in different size bubbles and at the same time visualize date ranges within themselves in pie slices.

Added an option to filter table rows when selecting one of chart sectors or columns.



 Added right alignment of data in total columns/rows.
 Added an option to hide the source table after adding the Pivot Table macro in the page view mode.
 Improved compatibility with Content Formatting Macros for Confluence app.
 Resolved the issue with copying a table with merged cells from Table Filter macro.
