

# Mark as Favourite

When you mark Talk inline comments and suggestions as favourites, you can:

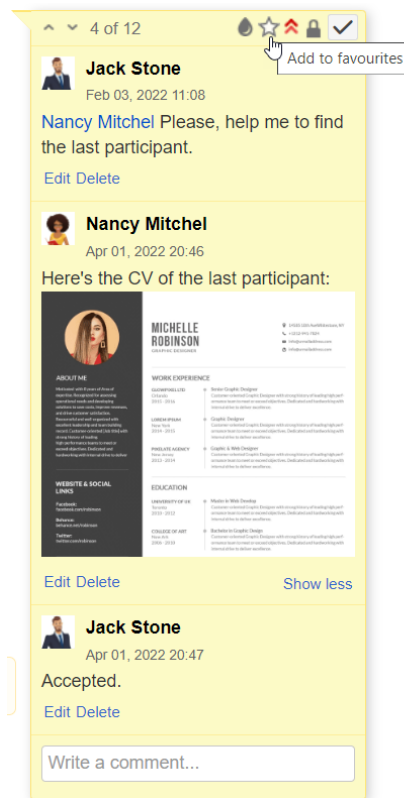
- see them at a glance on pages with numerous discussions and suggestions
- view and manage favourite talks from all spaces on one page

It's very convenient in such cases:

- there are ongoing discussions you want to keep track of
- you need to remember to answer some discussions and suggestions
- a discussion is almost over and a talk will soon be resolved, but it contains the information you will need to consult later on, so you want to keep this talk at hand after it's resolved, and more

## Adding to favourites

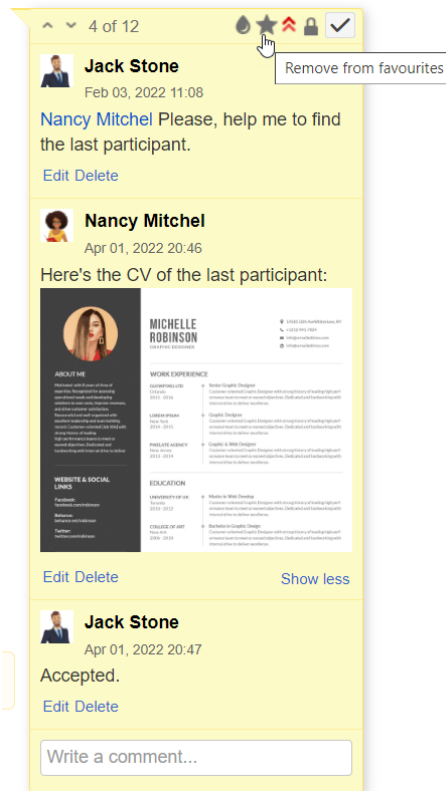
To **add** a discussion or suggestion to Favourite Talks, click  in its top-right corner:

## Removing from favourites

The star icon will change to , which means the talk was marked as favourite. You can click the star again to **remove** the talk from Favourite Talks:



You can add talks to favourites and remove discussions from Favourite Talks by clicking star icons in email notifications.

## Viewing and managing all your favourite talks

To **view** all your favourite talks, click your profile picture in the top right corner of the screen and choose **Favourite Talks**:

- Page title (the title of the page on which a Talk discussion is located)
