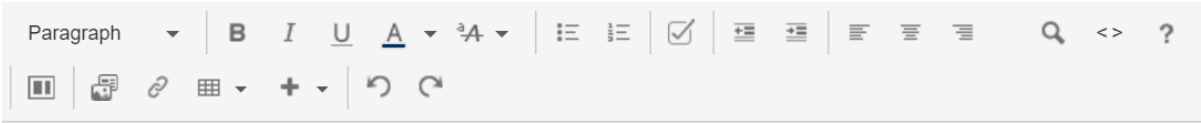

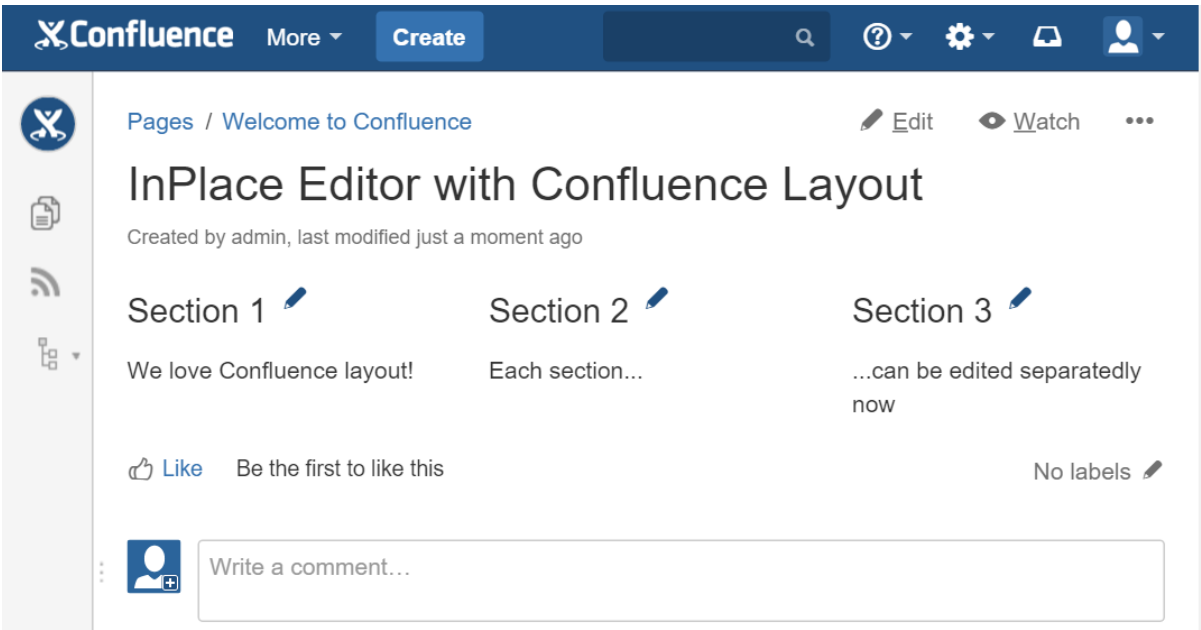

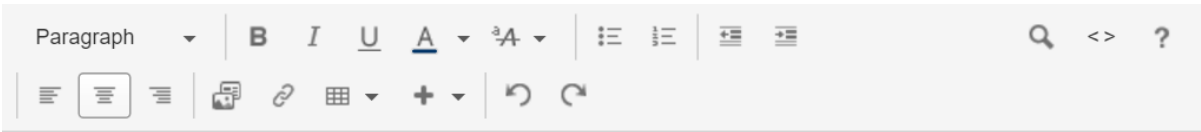

And that's done. Directly edit its content and save the section as usual:

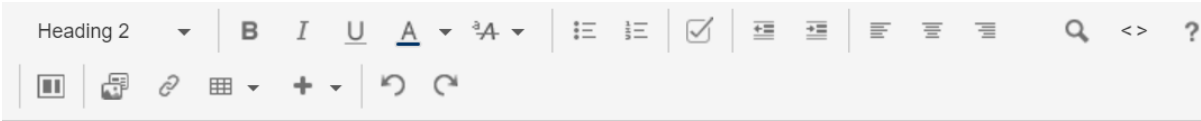
